Financial Report: Mr. Steven Zalesky (Mr. Michael Thyne, Chair, absent)

- Current balance is approx. \$5913.58
- Budget released to general committee highlighting Inter-Service Enlisted Dining Out would have a budge of zero along with other items such as Chapter Bullet Writing Seminar, Boots on the lane, caring hearts and MissouriVeterans home support.
- Budget was cut down by over \$8,000.
